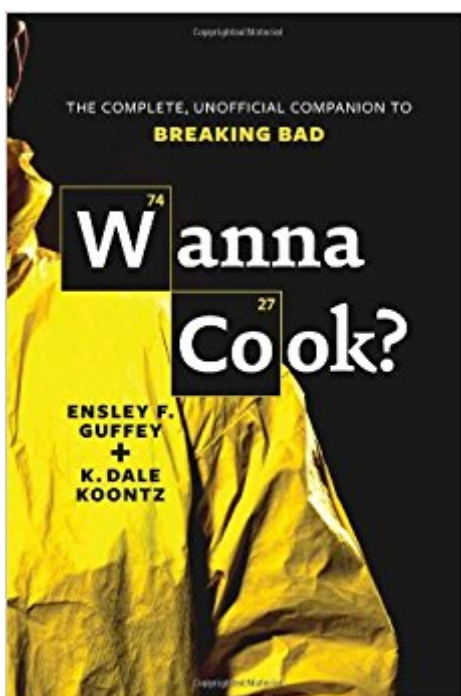


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Wanna Cook?: The Complete, Unofficial Companion To Breaking Bad

Not only is it a handy and informative episode guide, this hefty tome also delivers several insightful essays on what will soon be universally regarded as *The Greatest Television Show In The History of The Medium*. I cannot comprehend ANY fan of the show being disappointed with this well-researched, beautifully-assembled companion to *Breaking Bad*. Highly-recommended.

I thoroughly enjoyed this book. I am fascinated about hidden meanings and other people's take on what is happening in each episode. I was a latecomer to the series, I watched all 5 seasons in a month on Netflix. Each time I watched an episode I read the accompanying chapter. Each chapter assumes that is where you have watched up until and does not have spoilers. Then there are a few chapters that relate to the series as a whole and these have spoilers, so you simply read them after you're done with the series. Fun and comprehensive.

The book came out long after *Breaking Bad* wrapped last year, but I am delighted with it, and like the previous reviewer, it made me want to watch the series again, and I am doing so. The author breaks down each episode with interesting details, but very few spoilers. In addition to notable insights into each episode, it provides fascinating information on such subjects as chemistry, air traffic controlling, law enforcement, health insurance and so forth. It seems to be well-researched and informed, and is quite humorous in places. If you love *Breaking Bad*, you will Love this book!!
