The book had promise, but I had more than a few problems with it. Firstly, there are some spelling errors in the English sections of the book, which detracts from the explanations the book gives to English readers. It doesn't feel like the book was proofread very well. Second, the dialogue was very confusing, at least for me. Most books have dialogue that looks like this: "How'd you like the book, John?" Pedro asked to his friend. "The book was ok," John said. This book doesn't ever say who is speaking the dialogue, however. The usually conversation between two people looks something like this: - Do you understand who is speaking? - No, do you have any idea who is? - Nah, I thought you would know. Hey, uh, which one of us is speaking this sentence right now? - I think it's me, but honestly I can't tell any more - Oh #\$&% this I'm out of hereThis wouldn't really be a major problem because you can infer most of the time who is speaking anyways. But there's no reason that it should be written this way. It just adds another layer of confusion for those learning the language, and it can easily be avoided by just adding "*INSERT NAME HERE* said" at the end of each phrase. And lastly, I don't think the book is made for beginners. It's not a bad book, but it's marketed to the wrong audience. If you're truly a beginner and want to start to improve your vocabulary, I would not recommend this book for you. Too much new vocab is thrown in without translations. If you knew Spanish and want a refresher, then you won't mind. However, it was very difficult to look up almost every other word at the beginning of the book. It got better and I had to do it less often in the book, but it was still to much for my level. However, I'm not gonna trash the book because of my own lack of understanding of Spanish. There are a lot of positive reviews for this book, so obviously others understood it and enjoyed it. But they must be better at Spanish than I am. Although I do take responsibility for not being very fluent in Spanish, I wouldn't recommend this to a beginner / late-beginner of Spanish.

I speak four languages, but Spanish is not my strong asset, so I bought this book to improve my reading skills. Each of nine short stories is broken into smaller chapters, which makes it easy to go through. What I really appreciated is that in every story there is a vocabulary section, so you can double check the most important moments. It's still getting quite difficult for me, but I believe this book with short stories will contribute to my better Spanish. I can recommend the book for the beginners like myself.

I love this book! I've been learning Spanish for 6 months. I understand half the words, recognise a lot more that I should remember, and was able to get the gist of the story without a dictionary. With

3 chapters in each story, it is manageable and gives me confidence that I am progressing well. And the stories were entertaining.

This is not for beginners,rather for someone that has developed a decent vocabulary and understands the tenses. However,this book along with the audio version used together are a great method to develop understanding. Very good pogram

The stories were also very entertaining, even given that they were written for beginners. I'd say they are really intermediate level, but a beginner can certainly enjoy them.
