

This monograph offers a unique approach to wine tasting based on an analytical discourse on the elements associated with wine quality. The book takes each major component of wine quality including ripeness, concentration, balance, complexity, and wine finish among others, and relates them to various winemaking, descriptive, as well as some philosophical details. Essential stuff for the enthusiast. It is not a guide on the basic mechanics of wine tasting nor a tasting survey of wine styles, which can be found in countless other books. I found the book poorly organized and very poorly written with run-on sentences and grammatical errors. For example, she states that "grasping the merits and bummers of that nebulous area between clean and faulty needn't be overly daunting. Suffice to say that this whole subject of wine faults could on its own constitute a weighty tome and an onerously technical one at that." Simplify, simplify. You are an editor.
