

Like some of the other negative reviewers I liked the story line of the first book enough to buy the second one, curious to see what happened next. I definitely won't be buying the third one. I barely finished this one and was so put off by the end I had to write a review, the first time I've done that. The first major turn-off for me was nearly 100 pages where Russell is narrating, and the entire narration is done with his southern accent. I didn't mind it in his dialogue but to have every word ending with -ing instead end with -in' for all those pages was revolting. As if that wasn't bad enough we then have the author's attempt at an Irish accent with the Gancanaugh for 65+ pages, which

comes across as a combination of Swedish, Irish and da Bronx. Example: Brennus says in what is supposed to be a seductive voice, "I tink ye're looking at dis da wrong way." Or: "No one can say dat ye're unworthy ta be one of us, after whah ye did. Ye will be an asset ta da clan." I still hung in through the end, looking for at least a juicy sex scene -finally - between Reed and Evie. Instead there's a kiss...and then a final scene that indicates they've made love. That's it. Was this series written for children?? On top of all that, I found Evie totally pathetic. Her constant stupid and martyred decisions because "I have to save you all from me" got so tiresome I really don't care what happens to her in the next seguels.

After reading the first book, Inescapable, I had to continue with the series. Let's bring up some points that I have read in some reviews. First one, the language of Russell. Yes I agree with you

that it is taxing but so is the language of the Gacanaugh. It can be hard to understand and get through but get used to it because if you continue reading this series you WILL see it again. Second thought, how can Reed fall in love with a teenager? How can Brennus, Reed, and many other creatures see Evie for something much more than what she seems to be? Because she is and now so is Russell. I believe that somehow the story is going to escalate to show Evie and Russell for who they are. Something extraordinary. I believe that the character development is wonderful in the first book and continues to evolve and show the strengths and weaknesses for what they are. The twist in this book with the Gacanaugh is nothing short of a good imagination at work and again it will all work together in the end, at least I hope it will. Without giving too much away, I love how Russell becomes the hero in this book and we start to see how their souls long for each other. I am torn between who I want to win the girl and I know that this is not over, even with Evie binding herself to Reed. Everything she does, she does it to protect the ones that she loves. I have read the third one already and cannot wait for the next installment of this series to surface.
