Eric Powell is a writer and who has contributed work on such comics titles as Buffy the Vampire Slayer, Angel, Hellboy: Weird Tales, Star Wars Tales, The Incredible Hulk, The Avengers, She-Hulk, the Simpsons, and he is the creator of the award-winning comic book series The Goon. Brian Churilla is a comic book writer and artist, and is currently drawing the books Big Trouble in Little China for BOOM! Studios and Hellbreak for Oni Press. He is also the creator of the critically-acclaimed Oni Press series, "The Secret History of D.B. Cooper". His artist credits include: The Avengers and the Infinity Gauntlet, The Sixth Gun: Sons of the Gun, The Anchor and The Engineer.

I thought this book was a faithful continuation of the movie. I'm a big John Carpenter fan, and Big Trouble is easily one of my favorites. I was really excited to finally read this. The writing was really good. Jack Burton's character was really well written, and we get some background information on his character that was not in the movie. I did think that Wang's character was a little over the top compared to the film version. The plot is well paced and plotted, and really fits into the mythology set up by the movie. I thought the art was above average as well, however, some panels are muddled and it can be difficult to tell what is going on, but those panels are few and far between. I highly recommend this book to any fans of the movie.
