

But beyond that, he offers practical solutions and possibilities that ought to be implemented. Even better, these solutions are not just his dreaming stuff up. He has implemented these in his life and the lives for whom he is responsible, proving that they work. His solutions are not social experiments. They are common sense behaviors that have served societies well for millennia. This is a fairly easy read told in an interesting narrative.
