I was very disappointed to find that I had already read (and purchased) this before. Just one of his short stories found in Full Dark No Stars. 10/13/14 - I am glad to see they have updated the description and now mention that this was previously published in Full Dark, No Stars. I believe I will leave my rating at 2 stars though because of the original dishonesty and the fact that the better value would be to just buy Full Dark, No Stars for \$1.25 more.

Both of these stories were great, vintage Stephen King. I guess the first story asks the question: how well do we really know our spouses? The first story is about a couple who's been married for

28 years. One day the wife accidentally finds some ID cards of women in her garage and realizes that her husband is a serial killer. Her husband quickly finds out that she knows us secret and the rest of the book is about how they try to deal with the wife's discovery. The book was great in the beginning, but kind of fizzled in the ending. The second book addresses how far we are willing to go when we want something and what are the consequences of really bad choices. The husband in this story is ticked off with his wife because she wants to sell some land she owns to a company that wants to turn the land into a slaughterhouse for pigs, the husband wants to use the land to expand his farm. The story then shows us how far the husband is willing to go to ensure his wife doesn't sell the land and how he tragically loses everything bc of the choices he makes. This story was really eerie. I put it down a couple of times bc the story features rats, which I am afraid of. Kings description of the rats is so detailed and grisly that it made my flesh crawl. Several times I vowed not to finish the book but I'm glad I pressed my way thru bc the story was great!! Reminds me of Stephen King's earlier work from the 1970s. I would give the 1st book 3.5 stars and the 2nd book 5 stars.

I was not aware that this was just two short stories. I thought it was a novel, on "A Good Marriage" but that story is over and concluded at about 1/3 of the way through the book. Strangely enough, the "bonus story" takes up more content than the primary one. I had no idea, and was expecting the two stories to tie together somehow. Needless to say, very disappointed. I've since learned that this story (A Good Marriage) is also published in the "Full Dark, No Stars" book of his, and it's certainly worth paying the \$8 or so for that one because this should have been priced at about \$1-2, since it was so short. I was also expecting more of a surprising/shocking ending to the primary story, but it was very bland, almost predictable -- unlike many other of King's books I've read and enjoyed.

I am usually such a fan of Stephen King, but this set of stories just did nothing for me at all. I feel like Stephen King went through a slump and somehow these got published in spite of the mediocrity of this compilation. I even went back and tried to re read a story, thinking maybe I just missed something along the way, but these stories just didn't work for me. I'm sorry to say that these are just Not up to his usual fantastic writing standard.
