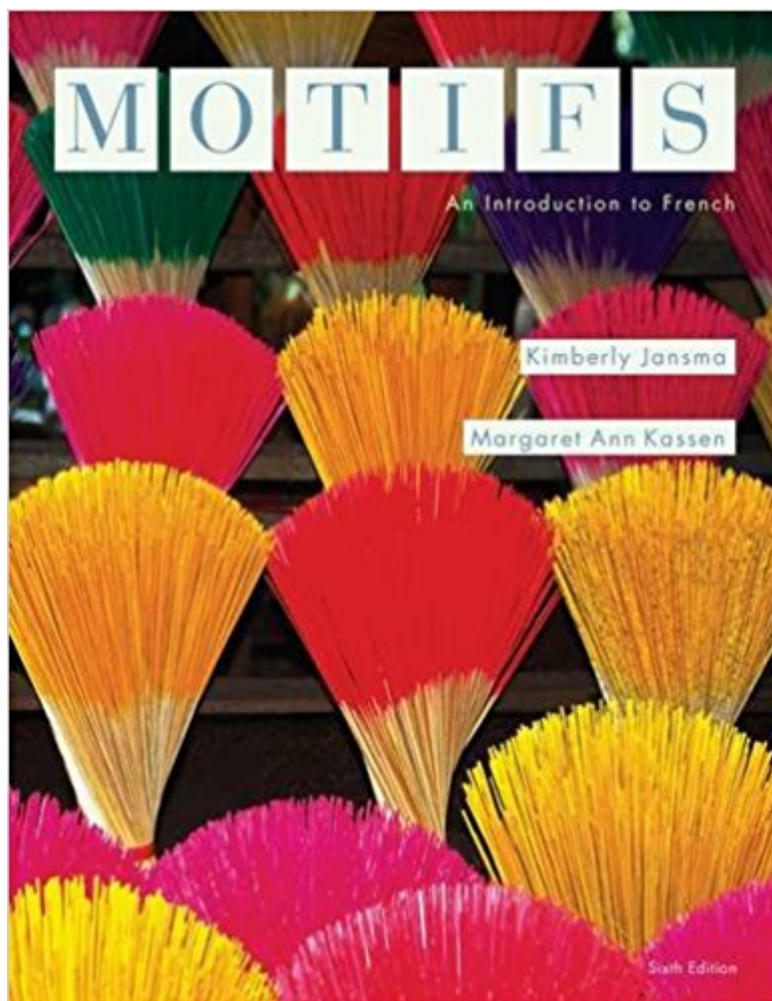

Her research interests include foreign language writing, performance assessment, technology-enhanced language learning, and TA development. In addition to presenting at conferences, Dr. Kassen has published articles on technology and writing and edited a volume on developing self-direction in foreign language learners. She received her Ph.D. from the University of Texas at Austin.

Don't really like the style of introducing new French words and phrases with minimal translations. They want you to pick up the meaning based on the pictures that accompany the lists of new words, rather than explicitly say "robe = dress." This works for about half the words, but the other half I don't understand the nuance between, for example, the French words for a man's shirt versus a woman's shirt. If you show me two pictures of shirts, and call them different things, I need to know why explicitly, not just the two different pictures. Probably a good book if you're taking a class with a native professor who can explain these things to you, but not a good book at all for learning on your own.
