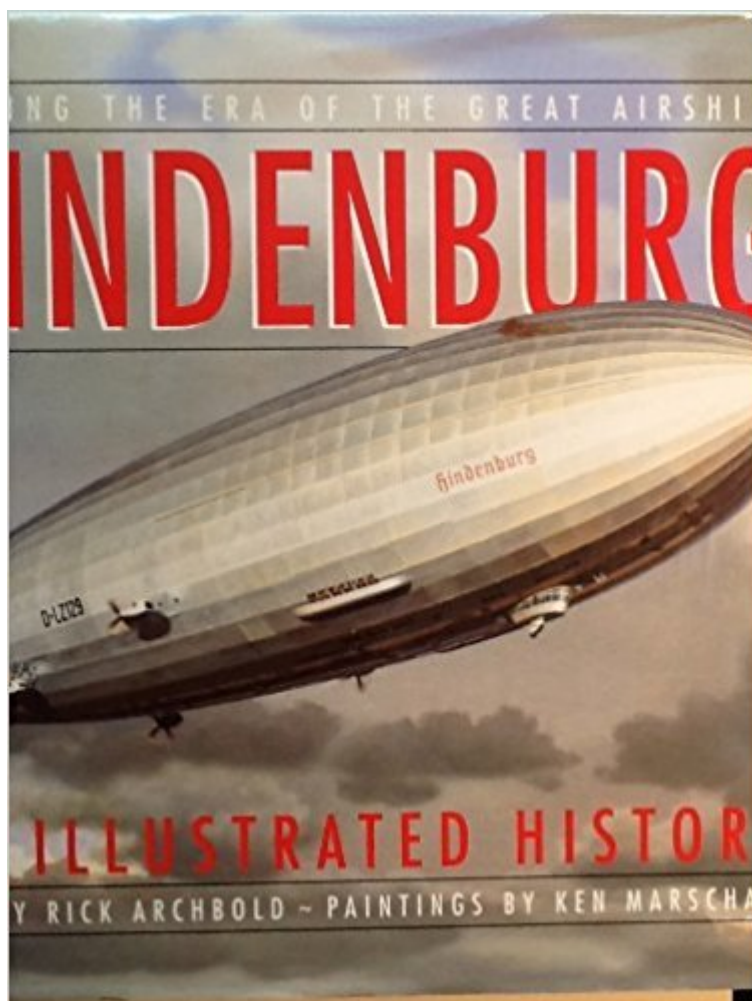

The brainchild of Graf von Zeppelin, dirigibles, for all their elegant majesty, were in constant search of a mission. They were used for sightseeing excursions, bombing London in World War I, exploring the Arctic, carrying airplanes, and then carrying passengers in luxurious comfort on transoceanic routes. Though each of these roles ended in a deadly catastrophe, a famously flaming one for the Hindenburg, the image of these stately behemoths persists in the imagination. Yesteryear soars spectacularly with this glossy album. Hundreds of photos restore the wonderment the zeppelins induced wherever they flew, as many frames include the gawking crowds they attracted. The text artfully supports the illustrations (and original paintings by Marschall) with details on the birth of rigid-frame designs, the delicacy of flying them, their promotion in the 1920s as superior to airplanes, and the peak of their development with the LZ 129, as the Hindenburg was designated before the Nazis pasted their flag and the wooden titan's name on it. My father witnessed the arrival of the Graf Zeppelin at the 1933 worlds fair in Chicago, with his parents, my grandparents. Grandmas' employer and his son held tickets to King George the 5th's coronation when the Hindenburg arrived that fateful day on May 6, 1937 when to their horror it burned itself to extinction in less than a minute. George and Harvey went on to publish their own impressions in a small book of their own contrivance. I myself held a piece of Hindenburgs charred outer covering in my own hands as a fellow student presented what was his own fathers recollection of that moment. Hindenburgs incredible sky technology helped define an era. As does Cloud computeing enhance our own time.
