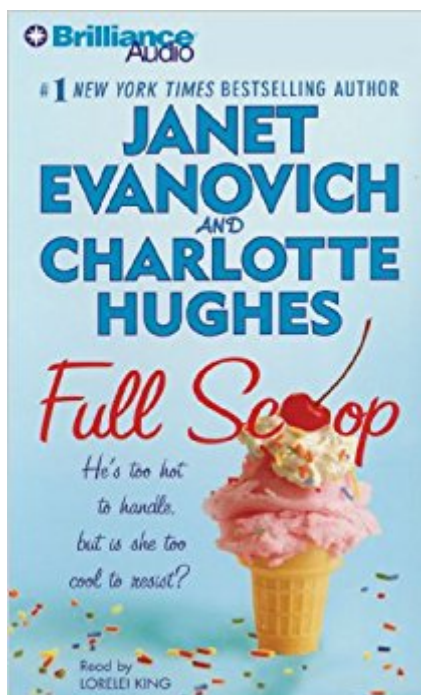

Hughes is a dreamer and lost in fairytale land about women. I don't know why there is always such a forced fairytale ending when Evanovich collaborates with Hughes. But portions of the story are believable, sort of, and it's entertaining. The interesting areas are with the doctor's daughter who is thirteen and her involvement with her own self interests. The doctor doesn't seem to be focused on her medical practice, at least the doing gets lost in the story. And then there is Queenie, a nurse and some kind of voodoo meddler. The villain is ruthless, there isn't a lot of emotional investment in his character.
