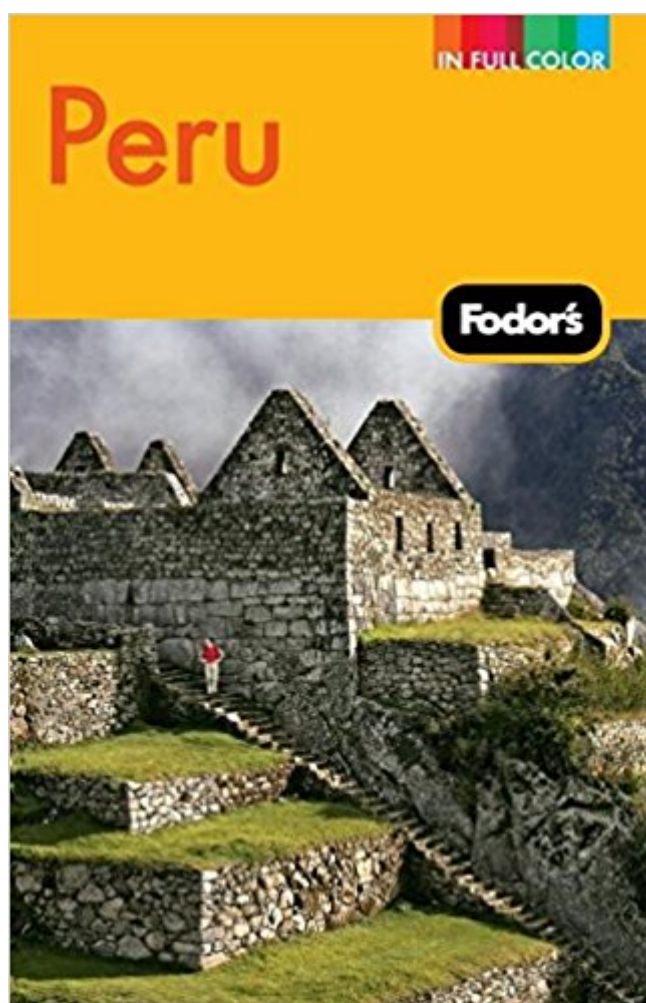

I bought this book a couple of months before my vacation to Peru and I was initially impressed. I liked the pictures and the content and thought it would be a very comprehensive guide for Peru. After reading this book, I bought the Fodor's Boston 2012 guide, which was a disaster. So as we were preparing to leave for Peru, I decided to buy the Frommer's guide also which turned out to be the better book but without all the pretty pictures. After the debacle we had in Boston, I decided I would use the Fodor's guide for our first day in Lima and see how it went. I packed the book in my luggage after the first day and used the Frommer's guide for the rest of the trip. The Fodor's guide got us lost during the one day I used it! The first thing I looked up was Taxis for Lima in the index

which said page 521. Well let's see what is on page 521-not taxis its translations for telling time and paying bills. Next we told the taxi driver to take us to Huaca Pucllana (a restaurant) the address on page 81 says General Borgono and the map on page 80 shows the nearest cross-street as Jose Pardo. Well, we go to that location and no restaurant here! But if you look at the map on page 64 which also shows Huaca Pucllana (this time the attraction) it is clearly several blocks from the map on page 80. How do two maps for the same thing in the same book show different locations?Very disappointing and I will never waste my money on another Fodor's guide. Go with Frommer's, we had no problems using it in the Sacred Valley and Cusco.

We found this book to be helpful and spot on.we used it to figure out where to stay and eat and what to do.
