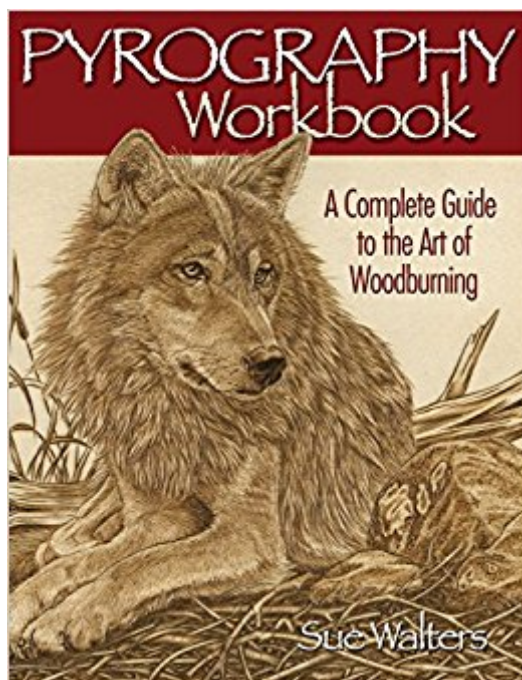

I decided to take up pyrography because I had a friend who wanted a memorial plaque for her dog. I figured my sketches would translate well into something more permanent than just a paper drawing. While I'm not skilled enough to burn a highly detailed drawing, I think my first attempt with the help of this book, came out fairly well. I do wish there was more discussion and illustrations on using the various nibs, but what she does present was very helpful to me. Update: I added a photo of my second attempt at wood burning. Mistakes, yes, but still amazed at what anyone can do!

I am just starting wood burning. This book focused mainly on nibs and I have a solid point. I would have liked more info on those type points. Otherwise, it had some nice projects, but I am going to look for a more basic book for beginners.
