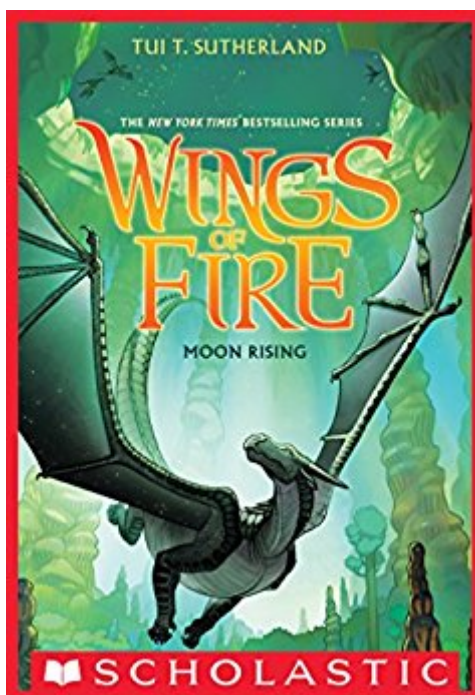

Synopsis

Ever have a child that simply hates to read? I have one like that. Because he doesn't ever read for

enjoyment, and doesn't enjoy it enough to try when he has to read for school, he struggles with spelling, language, and so many other things. My son was given book 1 of the Wings of Fire series for Christmas last year. He wasn't interested in reading it, but finally relented when he had a book report due. After all, it was about dragons, it has to be better than other books he's read, right? He LOVED it! He loved it so much that he read it a second time, used hard earned money to buy books 1-5. After reading those, he just had to have number 6. He read it in 2 days. I am so thankful to have finally found a way to get him to read. He is doing better in school since starting to read too.

Bought this book for my son who is reading the series. He loved it so much, he finished the book in less than a day. The first five books are about the war amongst the tribes of dragons. This book starts a new saga with a new group of dragons. The original dragons still exist but are not main characters starting in book 6. This book contains a murder mystery and a mysterious voice that calls out to Moon. These books are a good read for late elementary or junior high ages. The focus is dragons so you really have to like dragons to enjoy these books.

Warning for others who have read previous Wings of Fire books! This book starts a whole new story arc. New main characters and brand new plot. This time we have a whole school full of dragons and this book focuses on the adventures of 7 dragons called the Jade Winglet. They are all from different tribes and are learning to get along with one another. This book is terrific. Don't worry though! All your favorite characters from the last stories are still there and very involved!

My Thoughts: To be honest, my brother wasn't a big fan of the new books in the Wings of Fire series (Winter Turning, Moon Rising, etc). However, I really enjoy them, although I miss some older characters like Tsunami (who still is in the book for a couple scenes) and Sunny. Glory is in this series a lot more, being the queen of the Rain and NightWings. Moonwatcher (aka Moon) is an amazing character - everything was spot on and fit her perfectly. Quiet, intrigued, curious, wary, friendly - so many things rolled into one, yet they all came together to make Moon, Moon. Winter, Qibli, and Carnelian fascinated me. Plus, it was really interesting seeing Moon's perspective on their thoughts, and how she reacts to them in their sort-of friendship. Kinkajou, as always, was awesome :), as were all the other old characters. I can't go on enough about this writing - easy, speculative, more in the back of your mind so that you focus on the story, making this book devoid of dullness. Sutherland does a very good job of making me want to know more - the mystery is always something I look forward to in this series. The author eases you into it, giving away little clues at a

time until you realize what happened, either a split second before or after the characters in the book. Either way, this technique makes you cheer for Moon and her friends during the fire/explosion scene (also with the Icicle scene and Starflight). Of course, I HAVE to add in a part about Darkstalker.

DARKSTALKER. Ugh! I can't tell what's up with him - why are you doing this to me, Tui T.

Sutherland? The worst part is that Darkstalker isn't in the book that much in Winter Turning, leaving us on a sort-of cliffhanger. At times, Darkstalker seems kind, funny - similar to Deathbringer - but others, you can tell he's lying to Moon. He seems manipulative, yet at the same time, caring - but then you wonder, is he just caring about Moon because she's the only one that can free him? Overall, I just love this series, and can't wait to read more!

Good job Tui! Actually, I have a theory about how the prophecy will come true. The theory is that Jade Mountain is a dormant volcano, and the earthquakes in book 5 made it active again, and its eruption will be what "shakes the earth" and "scorches the ground". Also, here's what the first phase of the prophecy is referring to: Darkness of dragons: Flame (according to book 9, there's a high chance that it's referring to Darkstalker) Stalker of dreams: Flame (According to book 9, could possibly be Queen Scarlet) Talons of power and fire: Peril One who's not what she seems: Onyx/Sora Note: Those are only the most possible references.

This book is awesome. Great job, Tui T. Sutherland! I have read the 9 Wings of Fire books (and Darkstalker: Legends) and I am waiting for the tenth! In the meantime, I read this book over and over. It is one of my favorites. I totally recommend, this book is great! Also.... what if there was a NightWing named Silverwisher who had the strongest gift of prophecy in all of Pyrria: she knows what will happen instead of all the options. Just an idea -- a random kid

This book is starting a new adventure with new dragonets, and the original five are still involved, but older. They are running the school, teaching and guiding dragonets of all the kingdoms. They believe by joining all the different tribes will help the peace live on. Putting together all these different characters is a handful! Already a new adventure is starting, and it's going to be exciting!

I love this series of books! Moon is a NightWing born with mind reading and vision powers. All the other NightWings were only pretending to have powers. Suddenly when Moon arrives at Jade Mountain Academy a mystery voice speaks to her in her mind, Darkstalker. Darkstalker can read minds like Moon. That's why he can talk to her in her head. But Darkstalker has a big secret, can he

trust Moon to help him?
