

I've been reading this book at bedtime to my 5-year-old. Every night before bedtime she says "more dinosaurs please!" or "Mama, it's time for dinosaurs!" I really appreciate how much careful effort Ms. Howard has put in to expressing complex scientific topics in a way that kids can "get" it. We'll have to read it many more times before my kiddo really understands things, but it has been AMAZING to watch her learn -- to see the dawning of understanding on her face as she realizes how long dinosaurs roamed the earth and how short human history is, for example. It's an inspiring experience as a parent. But I've also thoroughly enjoyed updating my own knowledge about dinosaurs -- there's a lot scientists have learned about the history of dinosaurs on earth since I was a kid. (There's way more to learn than just about the whole "feathers" thing.) The illustrations are beautiful and engaging, while the text and character expressions include quick twists of humor that carry the story along. Love the whole package!

This is hands-down the best dinosaur book I've seen! It is a guided safari through millions of years, absolutely packed with dinosaurs, archosaurs, and other contemporary organisms living on land, sea, and air. Abby's illustrations are lush, detailed, engaging, and magnificent. They make you feel as though you are walking among the dinosaurs. Concepts in evolution are explained and developed throughout the book.
