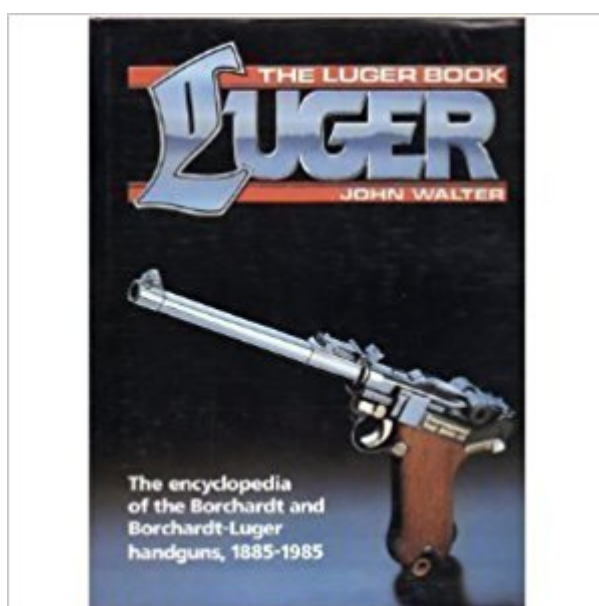

The information compiled in this book is invaluable to any Luger collector - altho the author may have thought he was clever in the way he presented the information - book is a virtual nightmare if you are doing research on a particular aspect of Lugers and their creation and history. If you have any interest in Lugers, this book is a must-have, but using logic to find something easily, ain't easy - that aspect of this book will drive you nuts

Very well researched book, plenty of useful information, but would have preferred a book with more photos of Luger variants, detailed breakdowns, operations, histories of Lugers as used by various militaries and agencies. Far too much minutiae and obscure details of no importance to me.

I'm new to Lugers and this book may help some I guess going forward. It is not easy to identify guns and very hard to follow. Lots of info but not much use if hard to find. Maybe I bought the wrong first

book? Don't expect base info on models etc laid out logically at least in my opinion!.

This is the best affordable Luger book on the market. I haven't read the really expensive ones, which may be more detailed, but this one has everything I was looking for.

If you are buying one more book to fill your Luger library and have no other titles to get then this one will fill that slot.
