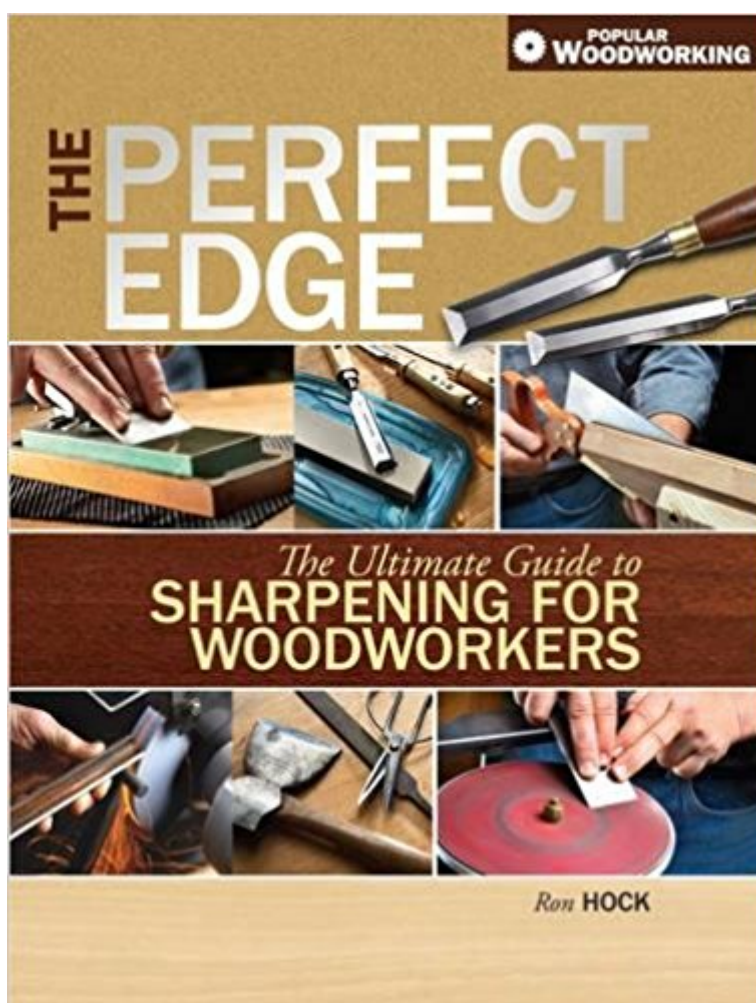

Ron Hock is the owner of Hock Tools, a twenty-five-year-old cottage industry that makes acknowledged superior blades for planes and other woodworking tools. Hock started the business when, as a struggling knifemaker, students at James Krenov's Fine Woodworking program at The College of the Redwoods in Fort Bragg, California, came to him for plane irons for the wooden planes they were making at the school. He tooled up for plane irons, learned about plane-making and found a niche-market of discerning woodworkers who appreciate a superior tool. In the ensuing quarter-century since making his first plane blades he's learned about tool steel metallurgy, cutting edge geometry, hand woodworking tools and sharpening.

Every aspect about woodworking tools that cut, starting with how the different steels are made and treated; to how to form the proper angles and hone the finest edge. Ron Hock shares his knowledge in a very easy to follow style. He will tell you how the fanatics do it and then share his thoughts about what is enough to get to excellent results without going over board. This is a very helpful book if you are like me and are just getting into using woodworking tools.

The sharpening of hand tools is the key to eventually developing competence and mastery of hand tool woodworking. It is the first set of skills that must be mastered to begin development as a good woodworker. Good work, even the simplest, cannot be done with dull tools, and they all must be well-sharpened even to compare them and select better and best from what is available for your individual task and style. This book is well-written and illustrated by one of the masters of hand tool steel blades, production and sharpening. Mr. Hock was one of the first producers of best quality steel blades, in quantity and at a reasonable price, for many hand tools widely available to the public for general use, and also one of the first to make available the information needed for the sharpening and maintenance of these blades for practical use. There are several good books out there on preparation and sharpening of hand tool blades, and all have their value, but if you are going to have only one book on hand tool blade steel and sharpening, I would recommend this one. If you already have others, I would still recommend buying this one in addition because of the valuable perspective it offers. This is the real thing, no BS, and the price is reasonable.

This is a great book about sharpening. It covers virtually all edge tools, has comprehensive information about materials and methods for manual and power sharpening and shaping of tool edges and even includes information about different steel alloys, hardening and tempering.
