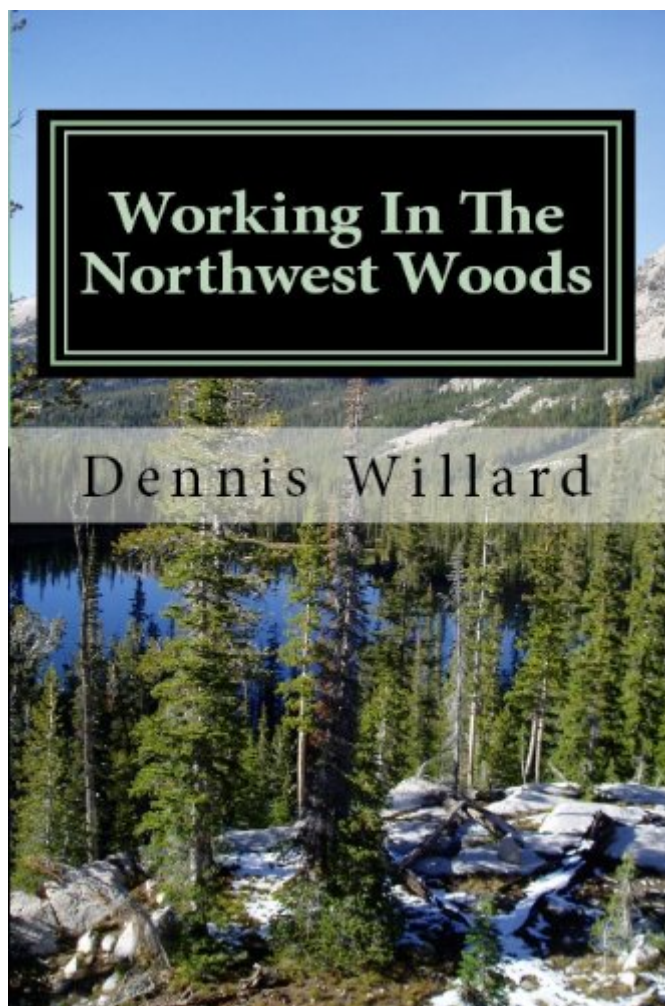

I picked this book as I thought it would be a fun read about the region of the country I live in. It was a fun read, certainly not a page turner, but fun nonetheless. Don't expect it to be a treatise on natural history or a guide to the regional outdoors, but enjoy it for what it is, a brief memoir.

I enjoyed reading it, but it is not for everyone. Having worked in the wood products industry, the information about logging, and managing forests was extremely interesting to me. My wife, however, did not even start the book.

I have not read this book yet. I can not review it yet. It sounds like a cool book to read though.

This title gives you the sense of sitting out on the deck with the author, listening as he tells you stories about his adventures.
