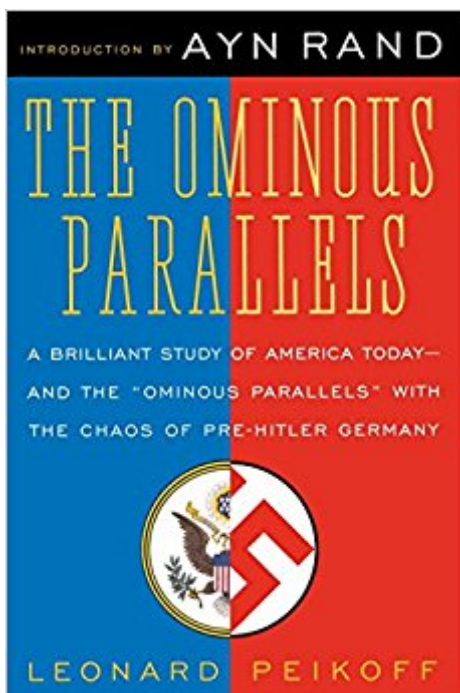

The single most important book on the cause of Nazism and the only book that identifies the cause at the deepest level: philosophy. A brilliant analysis of the ideas that led to Nazism. Superficial thinkers will complain that, for example, Kant was not a Nazi. True but this misses the point. Kant destroyed both reason and values, including the morality of loving oneself. The assault on reason set up the Nazi worship of the irrational will. The assault on the self set up the Nazi demand that the self is of no importance and that man must sacrifice for the state (volk). Kant's apparent defense of rights in politics is meaningless since his epistemology and ethics destroyed the foundation of rights. Peikoff weaves in the ideas of Kant and other philosophers and ties it all into pre-Nazi culture and the philosophies of the contending political parties into an integrated whole. A brilliant piece of philosophical detection and integration.

I read OP about ten years ago when I was looking for more-contemporary ideas from the Objectivist philosophy. I really enjoyed re-reading it on my Kindle, and I recommend it to anyone interested in hearing a Objectivist viewpoint of the rise of Nazi Germany. I've read Shirer, and Peikoff adds in the fundamental things missing: Why? Shirer explains the details of what happened, but has no explanation of how it came to pass. Peikoff provides these answers, starting with the concept that a nation's philosophy is what guides its actions and its results.If you want to understand why Nazi Germany came about, Ominous Parallels is the only consistent explanation. If you want to understand the current trends in the United States, Ominous Parallels is definitively Ominous.

Stripping the very content from a previous work, "The Ominous Parallels," which would help the reader make important correlations to the current ending of freedom in America today, followed by an inflammatory re-titling is an ominous indication of the objective of this book.My initial inclination

was to say, "Shame on you, Leonard Peikoff (whom I've admired, met personally and traveled with)," but I see he tactfully distanced himself (somewhat) from this work with the following: "For this reason, I agreed with the suggestion of Dr. Michael Berliner that I bring out this reduced version of my book. It was Dr. Berliner who first thought of such a possibility, who initiated the project, and who oversaw the development of its various stages. He wanted a book that would focus only on the Nazi aspects: on their intellectual origins in German philosophy, and then on their manifestations in Weimar culture and, as a result, in the world of Hitler." "Yes, let's avoid any inadvertent parallels being made, which is the "Ayn Rand Institute's" modus operandi. Don't buy this book, find a used or library copy of "The Ominous Parallels," read it if you can, then visit "ARLwatch" website for a more complete understanding of what "The Cause of Hitler's Germany" was.
