

We want our son to become a life long reader and providing books that he enjoys hopefully will help us accomplish that goal. He just started third grade doesn't seem to have any problems reading this book. It takes him a little under 15 minutes to read the chapter so he's usually reading a chapter and a half or two chapters night to meet his 20 minute go every day. He hates ending in the middle of the chapter, so fortunately, most nights he ends up reading two chapters which goes over his 20 minutes requirement. I didn't think it was as good as the first book, but my kids really enjoyed it and kept asking to read more and if they are enjoying it that much it deserves 5 stars in my book.
