

Revised and Updated. Author and photographer Laurence Parent updates this invaluable sourcebook with 21 new hikes, some popular and others unknown. Also, many new photos depict New Mexico's diverse landscape.

Laurence Parent is a freelance photographer and writer specializing in landscape, travel, and nature subjects. He has published thirty-six books, including Hiking Texas, Hiking Big Bend National Park, and many other FalconGuides. He lives in Wimberley, Texas.

I just received the book, and have already hit up a bunch of the trails. This book is written very well, and the difficulty levels are very accurate. It has good information about the water sources on the trails which is vital here in southern NM. I only wish it was a little smaller and water resistent, but then the price would skyrocket. Once again, another great book, at a great price.

It's well organized by regions and has a lot of detailed info. Hike descriptions are a bit dry. Star rating of the trails would be helpful.

One of the less helpful hiking guides I've purchased. The better guides I've seen have a summary chart of hikes, including difficulty level, etc. In fairness, this was a state-wide book while I was focusing on the Taos area. However, the map of Wheeler Peak hike seemed dated in that it does not show a connecting trail to Williams Lake. Fortunately, I got the Trails Illustrated map of this area and was able to get a much clearer picture of interesting trails than is provided by this book.

I was hoping for a book with a good selection of moderate to easy hikes around Santa Fe. I could tell from the index that there were 11-12 hikes in the mountains north of Santa Fe but it turns out that all but four of those are long, "strenuous" hikes of no use to my group of 75 year old geezers. I should have bought a guide limited to hikes in the Santa Fe area. There are several available, including one in the same series as this one and the local Sierra Club has just put out a new edition of theirs. I chose this one because I liked this author's guide to hikes in Big Bend. It might have been useful if the publishers had provided access to a page allowing one to see the degree of difficulty of all the hikes.
