

It has separate maps of these sights-clustered neighborhoods, and how to locate them. The last section of the book details the campaign by American, British and Italian soldiers to defeat the German occupiers of Italy during World War II. 360,000 Italians died fighting against the Germans and 100,000 American, British, French, Polish and German soldiers died in Italy. Information is given on how to locate American buried servicemen in Italy near Rome. The authors explain as knowledgeable tour guides, good friends and city insiders with the assistance of detailed maps, words and pictures. They write from experience working with handicapped adults and children.
