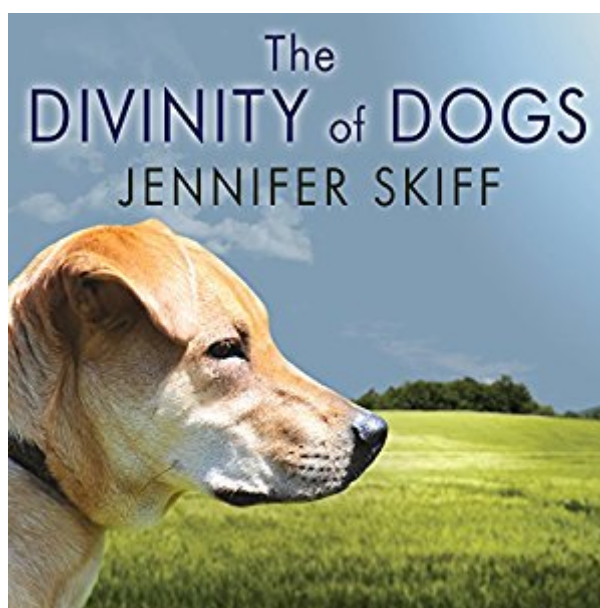

What's striking about these stories is how many of the dogs featured were rescues; rescued from abuse and neglect. What's more striking, is that each story illustrates that it wasn't just the dog that was rescued; it was the human who was rescued, as well. Their lives were changed forever from knowing a particular dog. Of course I boo-hooed thru it. It is not just the stories that Jennifer Skiff collected but her OWN story that makes this such a compelling book. Her writing has such a clarity & flow to it and her story is heart-breaking & heart warming all at the same time. Healing happens when we tell our stories. It also happens for the people reading them. Her book is a book of healing and hope, not just for dog lovers, but for anyone who has suffered abuse. It's divinely inspired. This book will have you appreciating your own 4-legged loved ones that much more. I had so many sweet memories of my others dogs come flooding back as I read each of these powerful stories. If you love dogs, you will find yourself reaching for the tissues. Don't let that deter you because you will also laugh and celebrate and have your faith in humanity restored by reading these stories. I can't say enough good things about this book.
