

This user friendly siddur is published by the Conservative movement's book service. What I like is that there is sufficient content so as to not render it unduly watered down. To me, the hallmark of a good learner's aid is content sufficient to give the user a sound understanding when he/she moves beyond the learning stage. This siddur will go a long way into into integrating young junior congregation members into the main Shabbat service when the time for fuller participation arises. The siddur is substantiallty written in Hebrew with lucid English translation and commentary. This is important because learners should be instructed to pray in Hebrew and they should understand what the prayers signify. I recommend that synagogues purchase this book in bulk for their junior programs. By the way, as of the writing of this review, did not sell this book directly. Therefore, it is necessary to order it from the publisher. The publisher is the book service of United Synagogue of Conservative Judaism.
