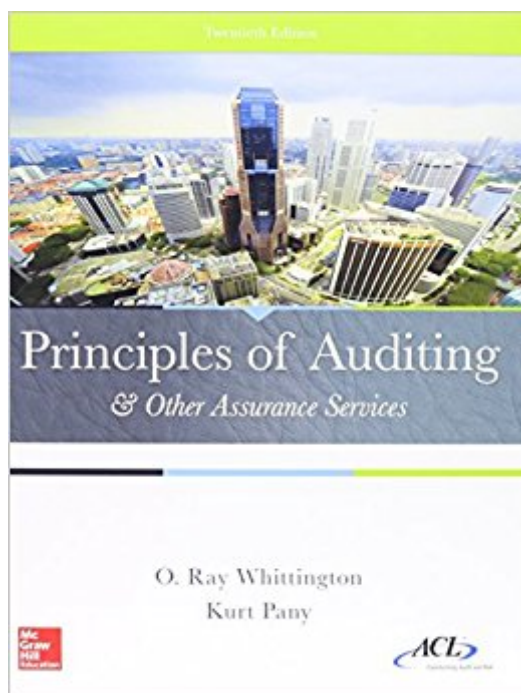

The author tries too hard to fancy up the book, just give us the information we need without repeating yourself over and over in different ways to make the topic hard to understand. I am have taken several accounting courses as I am about to graduate and this is the worst college level book I've had to date. It's really really unfortunate that students have to pay so much money for books that don't teach the material in an organized fashion.

Just finished reading chapter 1 and 2 and I can definitely say it simplicity is not its forte. Auditing and assurance are as complicated as it is. Following the GAAP alone is not enough sometime. The worst part is the school forcing you to use its online connect system because the facilitator is too lazy enough to come up with the test on their own. It's no wonder the US online education system is down the toilet.

Agree with previous reviewers about this book. This book is very hard to follow and understand. Instead of trying to break down concepts into it's simplest form and provide examples, the authors

try to use big words and repeat themselves over and over again. The best accounting book I have used so far explained the concept, gave examples of the concept, and then provided an exercise to practice the concept. Examples in this book are few.

I agree with the previous buyers' review. This textbook is extremely hard to read, offers very little examples to help students to understand, and the writing just repeats itself over and over again using big words. The presentation of the topics is very disorganized and difficult to follow.
