This is book four in the Vampires and Wine series. Once again Pepper discovers a dead body at Mugwort Manor. Out of reflex she calls the police before telling the Aunts...and they wish she hadn't. It seems the man was a former boyfriend of Aunt Agnes, and a member of the secret vampire council. A cleaner (Lucas) should have been called. But it is too late, so things progress through normal legal channels. Before long, Pepper and her aunts are trying to solve his murder. In the process of that, they invite a suspect to lunch to try and interrogate him. When he dies after drinking from the water bottle he brought with him, it becomes apparent to them that this victim must be connected to the first victim. The investigation efforts are increased in order to find the murderer before anyone else gets hurt. Unfortunately, Pepper gets hurt anyway. Her heart is broken as she witnesses Lucas kissing another woman, carrying on with call girls, and acting distant and suspicious. He doesn't even talk to Pepper, and when he does he calls her by her formal name of Valkyrie. What is wrong with Lucas? Who killed those men and who tried to poison Aunt Agnes? When will Pepper get to go back to her own cottage and be safe? So many questions to be answered by reading this fun and somewhat wacky episode of Mugwort Manor and inhabitants. Pepper gets a chance to learn more about magic spells from her aunts, as well as learning to appreciate her family and friends. Prepare for a surprise you never suspected, and I don't mean birthday dinner with the Aunts! One special bonus is the glossary the author includes for those of us who don't live down under. Unusual spellings and Australian terms add to the interesting book. When the art exhibit featured information on indigenous art to Australia, I appreciated the short

history lesson and things I learned.

I love Pepper and Lucas and I usually find the aunts interesting but this story was a case of "same thing, different day." I don't mind series that follow a formula but this one really was almost interchangeable with any of the previous stories. There's a death but very little suspense about it as there really are only three suspects and it is ridiculously obvious what is going on with one of them. There's the promise of a bit of intrigue with one suspicious character but it never really materializes. Pepper is ridiculously obtuse about something. She ought to be better at thinking outside the box by now. She gets trapped again. Nothing new there. There is a weary cadence to the story as if the author is just phoning it in. We learn very little about the characters that makes them more intriguing. I mean we do learn some facts that weren't previously divulged but they don't shed much more light on the mystery about the disappearance of Pepper's parents. I had expected some development on that front and there was none. There was some relationship development taking place for Pepper and a romantic interest but it wasn't particularly exciting or romantic. It was kind of shoehorned in among other events. I recommend reading other stories in the series or you won't really get much out of this book as a stand alone story. I really loved the other books in the series so I have to sadly admit I was a bit disappointed that this one was so threadbare and rehashed so many elements from the previous stories without building more onto them. I don't feel I have really learned more about these characters or that they have become more alive to me. Lucas...just barely becomes more intriguing but we don't get to see more come of what we learn about him here.
