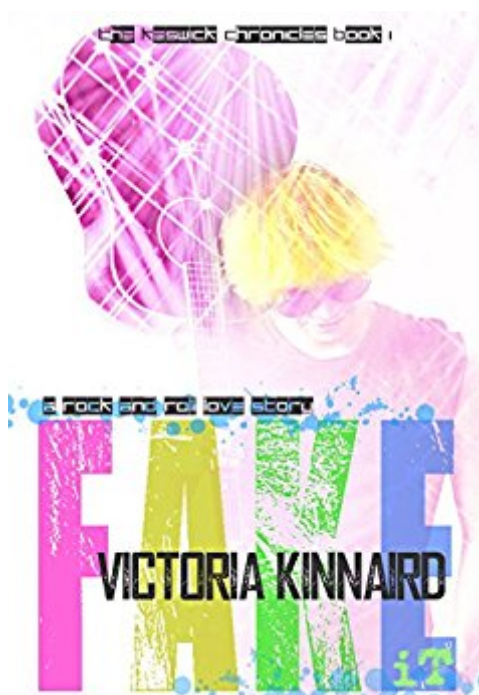

I gotta start out by simply saying I LOVED this book. The characters are so well defined, drawn so

clearly, and so likable. The characters really draw you in to the senior year high school challenges faced by Jack, who dreams of being a musician and of having a boyfriend. In comes JJ Keswick, who is a deliciously irresistible character. Flawless looks, popular, star jock, wealthy beyond imagination, but with challenges of his own. The ending of this book is great, and it sets up book two, *Take It*, very nicely. *Fake It* is billed as book one in the Keswick Chronicles. Book two comes out summer 2017. And I can hardly wait.

I was hooked from page one and was in suspense until the very end. I can't wait to read the sequel.

This is the first book I've read by Victoria Kinnaird and I love it! It has feelings, love, romance, pain, tears. It is very well written. I can't wait for the next one!

This book has all the elements you expect from a Young Adult novel. The geeky gay kid, the rich and spoiled jock, the female best friends and the silent guy in the background, who form a music band in high school. However, this book becomes more than a typical YA novel. The plot is wonderful, right to the very end.
