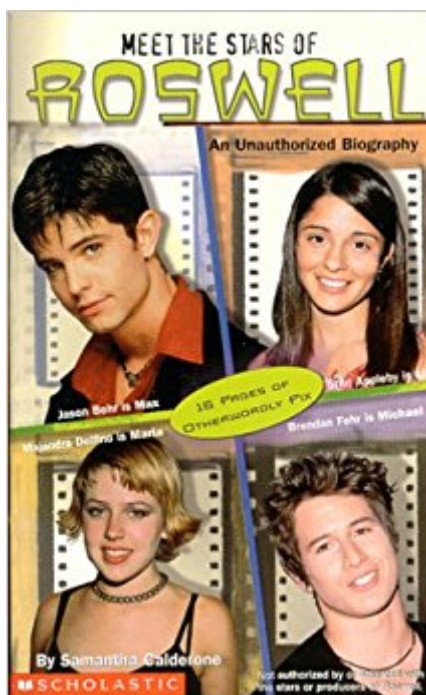

I would have enjoyed more pictures and just more general information, other than that, I really and thoroughly enjoyed this book. It has my seal of approval.

This book was the first book (to my knowledge) to be written about the Roswell cast. It gives great bios of Jason, Shiri, Brendan, Colin, Maj, Kat, and Nick! I was pleasantly surprised (usually unofficial books aren't this good) with the thoroughness of the material. It even includes a section of "what's on the menu at the Crashdown Cafe!" The colored pictures section is awesome as well--it even has pictures of the cast members BEFORE Roswell, like Maj with Tony Danza, and Brendan on Our Guys. There's also a cute picture of Majandra with Miko Hughes (arg, baby Nikolas!!!!!!) when they were in "Zeus and Roxanne." I found out a lot of things I didn't know, including where Brendan started (modeling in Canada). Any Roswell fan will truly enjoy this book!

There is some interesting information, yes, but there are also many inaccuracies, and unfortunately, it was more applicable a few years back.
