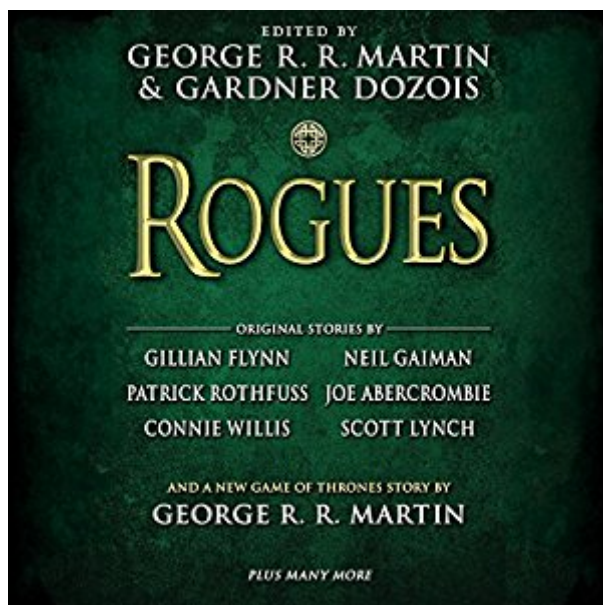

Haven't read every story yet, but all the ones I have gone through so far are very interesting. Solid short stories with many great authors.

This is a great anthology filled with some of my favorite authors! You'll pick up stray details about Bast in Patrick Rothfuss's "The Lightning Tree". I bought this anthology mainly to read that particular story but Gaiman, Abercrombie, and Lynch all have pretty good short stories. If you need something to hold you over until "Doors of Stone" or "The Slow Regard of Silent Things" this will do the job well.
