

This book has great pictures and lovely descriptions of local mushrooms. It's focused primarily on edible mushrooms and poisonous mushrooms that you need to be especially careful with. It doesn't even cover all of the edible mushrooms that I have encountered in this area -- no Hohenbuelia, for example. As such, it leaves out descriptions of inedible mushrooms that I still want to learn more about just from a naturalist's point of view. (Also, if you are looking for psychoactive mushrooms, this won't help at all.) It also doesn't provide photographs of the lookalikes -- for example, the pictures it gives for chanterelles and jack o' lanterns is really not sufficient for identifying confusing mushrooms that look like they might be either one. There aren't color photos of spore prints or what the cross section of mushroom caps looks like.Basically, this is a good reference book to have, but don't take this book out into the woods and start gathering mushrooms for dinner. Use it as a starting point and do more research on the mushrooms you find or get an expert opinion.
