This isn't the usual cozy mystery. The characters run the gamut from a child, to a teen, to a thirty something and on down the line. There are witches, shifters, and an assorted variety of magical types living alongside regular people in Whisteria. The main character is a woman who has pulled herself up by her bootstraps, so to speak, having raised her daughter alone after giving birth in her teens. Her witchy powers kick in after she moves to Wisteria to take a job as a librarian, and her

aunt and daughter try to help her when her impulsive nature lands her in trouble. There are lots of laugh out loud moments but there are also some scary nail biting moments. A new love interest in the form of her handsome werewolf neighbor rounds out the story. I hope this series goes on a long time, it is really an enjoyable better than average read.

This is the second book about the Wicked Witches of Wisteria cozy paranormal/romance mysteries and actually was a pretty good story. There is not much romance in this one and the ending is a bit confusing but overall it was a most agreeable book. I'm definitely looking forward to book 3 in the series.
