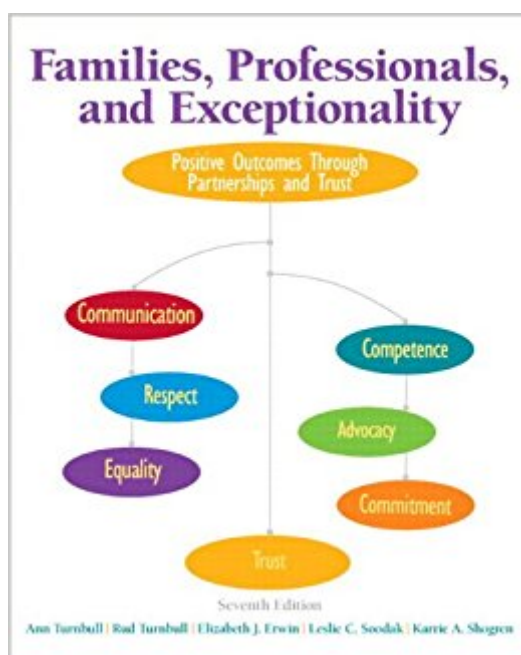

This text book clearly describes and guides a student through processes, situations, and laws that they will encounter as a Special Education teacher. The book uses "Family Stories", which guide you (the student) through that specific chapter. I found this textbook to be extremely easy to follow and read. This is one textbook that I plan on holding onto for future reference.

It was a good read. I normally prefer an actual book, but had to get a Kindle version due to time constraints. It wasn't bad. I will consider purchasing this way again.

My book arrived in great condition, and it has been an interesting and informative read so far. But just because it is a textbook, it is extremely overpriced. (And is the cheapest I could find.) This would be better if the book was a higher quality. The pages are very thin. The cover is flimsy, and has curled from the humidity in my house (which isn't excessive.)

Have a binder ready to keep things in order. Etextbook is only the text, no quizzes or other supplemental resources, so I wouldn't open it and get a better buyback price.
