

The aim of Lemniscates's books is to stimulate children's talent by creating stories with tenderness and imagination and at the same time stories that deal with real life.

We were talking about mindfulness in the children's Sunday school class that I help teach. The text of Silence is engaging and speaks directly to the ideas we wanted to share. The illustrations are simply beautiful. Silence greatly enhanced our gathering that Sunday morning. Awesome book to help my daughter settle down for bedtime or a nap. Also great for helping her remember to slow down and try to notice the little things and her surroundings.

Beautiful artwork from the artists at Lemniscates. The story follows a girl as she learns to listen to what can be heard when no one is talking. It is a peaceful, thoughtful story, without too many words. It helps slow down the child. This is not a plot driven story. It is a simple introduction to contemplation and mindful listening in an appropriate way for children 3-7.

This is one of the most beautiful children's books I've seen. More about "listening" than silence, it brings the reader (adult and child $\tilde{A}f\hat{A}\phi\tilde{A} = -\tilde{A}\hat{A}$) to a quality of tender attentiveness to the world. The art work is gorgeous. My grand daughter was captivated, and I ended up making gifts of this book to everyone I knew with children under ten in their lives. Universally appreciated.
