I am shocked that I am the first to write a review but as soon as I saw on the Forum that the book was out early I downloaded and started reading. The story continues right along, hitting all the many different occurrences that happen with different characters including new to the story characters. I love that Michael writes this way and jumps around to show you all the action. I don't want to accidentally put in any spoilers so I will just say that if you are up to book 9 in the series this one is just as good. If you are just stumbling onto this series you must go back to book 1, if you enjoy that one you are set for eight more.

Ran across the Rise of Magic series and was intrigued, so decided to purchase all 16 books in the Kurtherian Gambit series. I then spent the next 4 days reading all 16 of them, then moving on to the Second Dark Ages and Trials and Tribulations series. This is a very entertaining and intriguing take on Vampires and Werewolves. I am eagerly awaiting book 17. And while there were warnings about the cussing in the book I found them to be hilarious. As far as military Scifi goes, I would easily rate this up there with some of the other major authors in the genre, such as John Ringo's Possleen War or Through the Looking Glass. Looking forward to enjoying the rest of this series, and the best part Michael Anderle seems to be a fairly prolific author so not a massive wait between books.

I've really enjoyed this series but I have to admit I hate what happened in this book. That's an extremely strong word, I know, but it's so true. I know these happenings are necessary for the story to progress but honestly it kind of ruined it for me. I still love the characters and the world the author created. I also love reading about the battles and tribulations the group faces. I just can't get past

the loss. I'm unsure if I'll keep reading the series. Regardless thanks to the author for such a great ride.

Other than #1 that started a great epic story, this was by far my favorite installment so far. I found this one richer and more complex, evoking emotions running the gamut. At the very heart of this story is the creation of a universe that gives strong heroes that I can completely cheer on without any reservation. It is doing what I wish I could do if I had unlimited power and resources...vanquishing evil and building for the good of world -- without having to make political contributions, schmooze petty bureaucrats, or compromise convictions.
