

Ken Johnson is an author and lecturer who speaks on a variety of issues related to Bible prophecy, ancient history, and the apostasy that will form in the church in the last days. He received a doctorate in theology from the Christian College of Texas, Texarkana Tx, in 1989. He is also the author of Biblefacts.org.

After being a believer in Jesus Christ for 64 years, I had heard about the 7 Feasts of Israel and people even came to my church and showed us how to do a Seder Dinner. (Passover for the Jewish

people. I saw a book about the feasts and it peaked my interest so I began a study. I cannot believe no pastor has ever preached about these. I guess they thought they were just for the Jewish people to keep. We do not need to keep the feasts but we need to know that the feasts have 2 meanings, one for back in bible times and the other foretells events for later. The Spring Feasts, Passover, First fruits etc. foretell of the Death, Burial and Resurrection of Jesus. Of course Pentecost is the beginning of the Church and then the Fall Feasts foretell the Rapture, the Atonement (Tribulation and Jews looking on Him who was pierced (not recognizing the Messiah) and the Feast of Tabernacles is Millennium. We should all study these and be aware of what they tell us for end times events. It is VERY IMPORTANT!!!!

I have been observing the feast/festivals for quite sometime and thought that I knew most things about it...but truthfully there are some very interesting facts that I didn't even know. This is a really good book for someone interested on what is done on the Jewish traditions itself and why all the festivals are really all about the Messiah once it is put together. Anyhow....it is very good.

What can you say? If you want a better understanding of Bible prophecyand how it relates to these ancient festivals, you'll want to read this book. The author provides a simple, straightforward discussion of essential aspects, written in a way anyone can grasp. Highly recommended.

Ken Johnson often takes liberties to insert other doctrines and beliefs into his "historical" "factual" research. spiritualizing scriptures and far stretching context to assign an arguable doctrine to otherwise plain and easily understood scripture. This is the second book I have read from this author. His facts are for the most part accurate but in this 2nd book I have found several facts to be incorrect. Some of the Hebrew is out right incorrect. These errors may be simple mistakes but it causes me to reconsider the other facts presented. I may re-read this and put some claims of evidence or his conclusions to the test.

I haven't finished it yet, but so far so good. Very good information on each feast, and really good references from the early church fathers. The feast really do give a detailed account of what has happened in the past, and I believe paints a picture of what will happen in the near future. I have read other books on the same topic that were very good, but this book kinda puts it all together from Genesis to Revelation from the old testament saints to the apostles and even on to the early church. I pray you are as blessed by this book as I have been so far.

I have studied the Feasts of God and I love how Ken Johnson intertwines the prophecies of the festivals with the order of prophesied soon coming rapture and other events. You can bet it is a pre-trib rapture! Dr. Johnson does an excellent job of demonstrating this directly from the Bible. If you are a serious student of the prophesies of the Bible, You might also want to read his book "Ancient Messianic Festivals: And The Prophecies They Reveal" and "Ancient Book of Daniel" as well as "Ancient Prophecies Revealed: 500 Prophecies Listed In Order Of When They Were Fulfilled" In my knowing that Daniel's weeks of years are tied into the Shabuah (7 year sabbatical Shemitah year cycles), Ken Johnson brought the weeks of Daniel to life for me. Jesus will remove all those who are His off of the planet at the end of a cycle and the tribulation will start at the beginning of a cycle. I have absolutely no clue which year just the signs Christ said we are to watch for foretold in prophecy. Dr. Johnson also interprets history and Biblical data correctly placing the crucifixion [during a tetrad of blood moons and sackcloth suns over Israel] in 32 [and 33] AD using Daniel's timeline. He had to account for rulers changing the dates and times just as Daniel prophesied would occur. God had the crucifixion take place at exactly the right timing of the sacrifice to the minute on the correct day. Every spring feast fulfilled to perfection. There is no reason to believe the falls feast prophecies won't be the same right down to the exact minute day and year. Since the Book of Daniel has remained sealed, and only recently started to become an open book, I believe we will be seeing and understanding more and more prophecy as we get nearer to their times of fulfillment.Dr. Johnson also reveals the four hundred years of Biblical history that for centuries has been called missing history. It wasn't missing, it was simply written ahead of time and fulfilled to perfection! I look forward to reading his next publication.
