I got this book free and have not read the first book in this series. Usually, an author includes a bit of

background information in the form of memories or a prelude or something to explain what has happened prior to subsequent books in a series. This author did not. I found it confusing and not worth going back to read the first book for. Ruby is apparently a goddess and is at a school for teenage goddesses and guardian angels who are not supposed to become romantically involved with one another. However, she is in love with her guardian angel, Eli. In the previous book, Ruby apparently was a vampire for a while and the vampires are the enemies of the gods and goddesses and guardian angels. Ruby and Eli are called upon to help the "higher power", a mysterious entity who runs their school. To their shock, he is a vampire. He turns Hunter, Ruby's friend who is also in love with her - because all teen YA paranormal romances must have a love triangle - into a vampire - because all teen YA paranormal romances need vampires too. Lust, betrayal and confusion abound in this book. I am not going to read the others in the series.

After reading her first book, I knew I had to have the next book in the series! I was able to jump right in and continue on with where she'd left off in the first book and it felt as if there hadn't been any lapse in the story line. Quick-paced and engrossing, I'm grateful I got it on a weekend because I couldn't put it down! This is yet another amazing up and coming author and I'm looking forward to reading whatever she puts out next!

I finished reading the 1st book, Guardian Angels, and immediately downloaded Sun-Kiss, Book 2, on Monday, 1/7/13. I finished it last night, Tuesday, 1/8/13 - only 8 hours from start to finish. Wow, Skyla's imagination is too awesome. This sequel flows so smoothly from Book 1, no trouble picking up. I was so glad to see that Ruby and Eli had a reunion, or so I thought it was a reunion until . . . Ruby was not expecting, nor was I, the tormenting job she was offered by the higher power. The fringe benefits were totally disgusting yuck. Read for yourself. You can feel the charged emotions in this book 2 and also book 1 - good, bad, tender, horrific, sick - you really can. I hope the author is contemplating coming out with Book #3.

The first book feels. and has a lot of similarities to the vampire academy. I liked it. But then I find out that this is really a dystopian series and heaven is ruled by a bloodthirsty vampire who wants to harness angel blood like cattle. Her friends are hurt in front of her and she does nothing. She is

supposed to be this immensely powerful sun goddess and she does nothing? The school slut she fries like an egg, but Satan himself hurts her friend and she stands by helplessly? In what universe does that make sense? This is feeling more and more like the Hunger Games and I hated the Hunger Games.

God I really wanted to like this book....there is so much potential but the execution is lacking. I still couldn't connect with the characters and this is the second book. She loves Hunter too...? What? Last I checked she barely tolerated him. The best advice I could offer this author is to show more and tell less. I don't want to be told how the character feels, I should be able to feel it, understand it, because it was built up with details....Ugh, this story could've been one of my faves. Sad...

As the main character grows and evolves, so does the story... the writing becomes more mature and complex.. it's written very well. In this book, Ruby learns the extent of her goddess powers... she is not only a goddess, but one of the last Heelian's in the world... she can harvest the power of the Sun within her, and she will need it more than ever now that she is working for the Higher Power

For such a young author, I am pleasantly surprised. There are many books in this genre and most of them are really bad. The story flows, the characters are very likeable. Some parts surprised me. I still feel that Ruby makes some very bad choices (SPOILER ALERT in the final fight I would have used all my power). I love Hunter. This is the second book in the saga and I am looking forward to reading the third one.
