

Nice book, good lesson. Bought after my niece was caught telling several "fibs":)

The overall tone of the book was positive and Brother and Sister did eventually confess to breaking the lamp after first lying about it. The book showed well how your conscience should get the better of you, though it was not clear to my young listener why Mama's sad face was the guilt trigger. Also, at the end of the book, the kids were never punished for breaking the lamp or lying. At the very least, they should have had to apologize for lying in addition to apologizing about the lamp and, really, they should have had to earn money or use allowances to buy a new lamp since the break in the lamp was so obvious. We used this book to discuss what is lying, though at first my preschooler was very confused about whether the bird was real or not real. As with some other Berenstein Bears book, this book was a springboard for teaching and discussion but might be better used with an older child.

I will continue to buy the Berenstain Bears books, I just love them, they are great ways to teach hard lessons for kids to learn in a fun way that keeps them engaged and wanting more.
