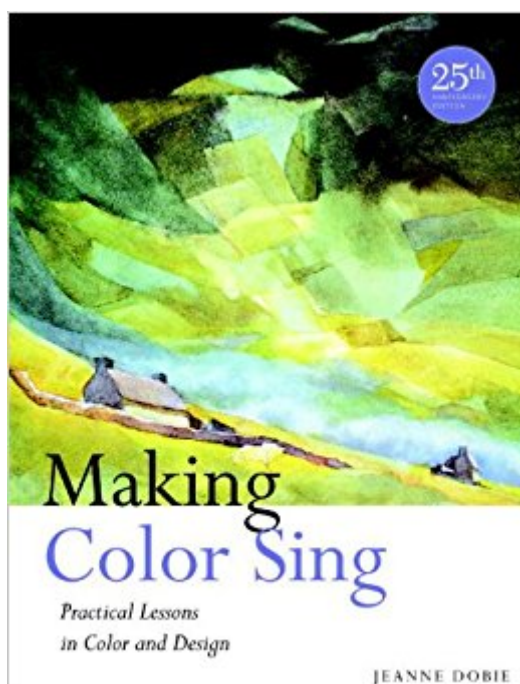

Jeanne Dobie, a teacher and painter whose work is shown widely and often wins coveted awards, lives in Pennsylvania. She is an extremely talented watercolor painter who was a Juror of Award for the 2007 and 2014 American Watercolor Society International Exhibitions. Dobie's work has been featured on various covers and articles.

Making Color Sing is one of the better books that talks about colours. The main medium used in the book is watercolour, although it's strangely not mentioned in the title or the book description. The 31 lessons in the book are quite comprehensive with practical tips on usage, and also explains the thought process behind using colours. They cover picking and mixing colours, controlling greens, understanding warm and cool, using colour for shape composition, values, creating transitions, and much more. There's a sizeable amount of content devoted to glazing, and the differences compared to mixing. There are occasionally exercises. There's quite a bit of text to go through, but it's a really insightful read. The author Jeanne Dobie is clearly very knowledgeable about pigments and can explain effortlessly on how and why mixed colours appear as they do, and the underlying pigments that control colour shifts. One of the highlights of the book is about using colour as a design element, such as picking out shapes and using them as composition elements. Overall, it's a great watercolour instructional book that can be read again and again because there are lots of useful information. It will give you the knowledge and all you have to do is go paint and experiment. Recommended to beginners to advanced watercolour artists. (Check out more pictures of the book on my blog. What a beautiful book this is! I return to it often because I haven't yet mastered the great volume of information Ms. Dobie includes. For example, the talks of mouse power (luminous grays), oceanic color, the many possible greens to be made, push-pull (and turn) effect when working with warm and cool colors, dark glows, singing color, white glows (the many shades of white), glazes -- the art of not mixing -- and multilayered creativity, color bridges, quieting with color, weaving color through space, abstract patterns, limiting the composition to a limited number of shapes, negative painting,

values, the impact of white...and more. It's a wonderful book to study and enjoy (the beauty!) and work with.
