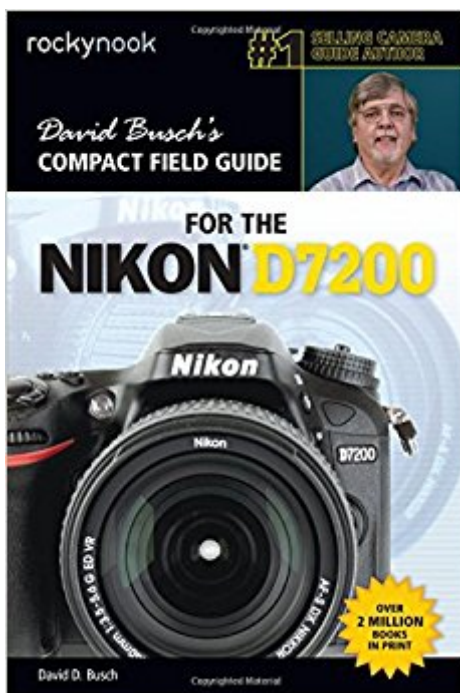

With more than two million books in print, David D. Busch is the world's #1 best-selling camera guide author, with more than 100 guidebooks for Nikon, Canon, Sony, Olympus, Pentax, and Panasonic cameras, and many popular books devoted to digital photography and imaging techniques. His best-sellers include *Digital SLR Cameras and Photography for Dummies*, which has sold more than 300,000 copies in five editions, and *Mastering Digital SLR Photography*, now in its Fourth Edition. The graduate of Kent State University is a former newspaper reporter/photographer, and operated his own commercial photo studio, shooting sports, weddings, portraits, fashion, architecture, product photography, and travel images. For 22 years he was a principal in CCS/PR, Inc., one of the largest public relations/marketing firms based in San Diego, working on press conferences, press kits, media tours, and sponsored photo trade magazine articles for Eastman Kodak Company and other imaging companies. This is the 3rd David Busch compact camera guide I've bought. I do like the the way he organizes and explains the camera features and have never found them to be be boilerplate versions of general photography books. Granted, some things will apply to all cameras regardless of make or model but I always find instructions and explanations specific to whatever camera I'm trying to learn. In the case of the Nikon D7200, I found the photography section (particularly the item-by-item camera set up instructions) point on, clear, and well-explained. I might or might not go with his particular choice but, at least, I understand the implications of going another way. I am used to still photography and understand what I'm choosing when I choose most settings. In respect to the video part of the instructions I found that section less clear. Granted, it is not something I have ever had to do or make decisions about. As of now, I still haven't set those preferences or used that function of my camera. I'm still using a separate video camera to take videos when I need to. I don't find this part as easy to understand as the photography section, but that's probably my fault because I don't grasp the benefits or consequences of one setting over another. I've had the camera for 3 months and haven't taken a single video.

So far I haven't found anything in it that wasn't common sense and/or already in the owners manual, so if you have no manual this would be great.

David Busch again publishes the best. Great guide. It makes me understand my new Nikon D7200 fully. Thanks, David!!!
