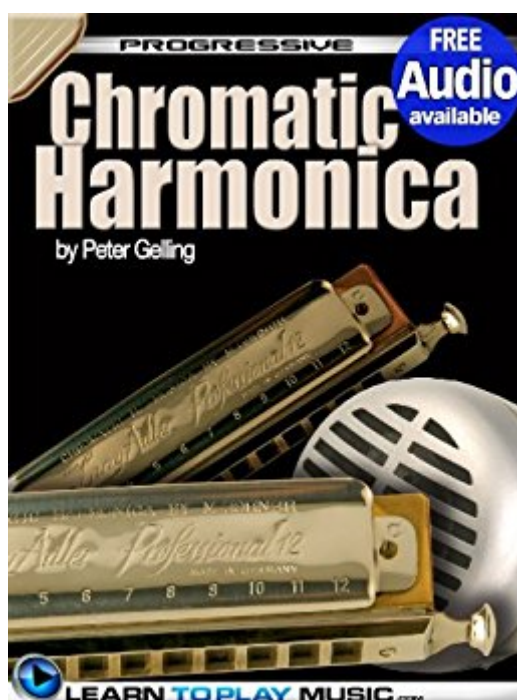

The music files that come with the ebook aren't with the book. The publisher suggests reading the book online. That is no help whatsoever. To get around this problem, the publisher has kindly arranged for the reader to go to their web page and input a code to access the files on line for free. Unfortunately, the page requires a subscription, and there's nowhere to input the code provided with the book, so the free files are not as "free" as they are claimed to be. Without those files, most of the sections of the book are meaningless. "Here' is what Middle C sounds like." [Nothing] The button doesn't work. Moreover, they book tries to explain a time signature. For example 4/4 time means there are four beats in a measure, and a quarter note gets a beat. Unfortunately, instead of 4/4, the character is displayed as * [that's right, an asterisk. As if that is supposed to be some sort of musical score or notation.]. There also doesn't seem to be a "HELP" button or a FAQ page for this particular title, just for the entire line of "Learn To Play Music" products. Apparently, the only way to access help for this title is to purchase it AGAIN, this time, rather than from , from the publisher. Maybe buying the hard copy would work... provided the CD the ad says accompanies the book actually exists, and is not just replaced by a code to a web page that doesn't work. I'm asking for a full

refund, as soon as I figure out how to do that.

This book is ABSOLUTELY BRILLIANT! I can't believe some of the negative reviews I've just read about it. It is DIFFICULT however if you are serious about learning to read music, some music theory, playing in all keys, or out of the box you must take the time and work thru this book. I've read almost everything out there about Chromatic Harmonica but this and David Barrett's are the best. I've been studying this book for a couple of YEARS now but good things take time especially if your not trained in music. I'm learning about Intervals now and its amazing how skilled I'm getting. I just wrote Peter Gelling a note thanking him for his work on this publication on Chromatic Harmonica

Firstly, you have to accept that some knowledge of music theory is needed to play a chromatic harmonica. There are instruments that you can 'learn by ear' but the chrom is not one of them. And you will need to be able to read music in order to use this book. Tablature is used for the first few lessons, but after that it's standard music notation all the way. Some basic theory and pointers on reading music are in the book, but theory isn't fully covered by any means. The author takes you through the process of learning the chrom by having you learn songs, including many he has written himself. Each song is a little more complex and involves new techniques. He guides you through various techniques, and the included CD is a huge help. The mandatory scale practice is here also, but it is presented in such a way as to remove much of the drudgery. There are even pointers on microphones and amps, working with other musicians, and getting over stage fright. This book is a great buy if you are serious about learning the chromatic harmonica.

I wouldn't recomend this book to anyone. It's overpriced for its content. It contains almost nothing in terms of how to play the chromatic harmonica, but does give a fair amount of info about music theory and reading music. The Complete Idiots Guide to Playing the Harmonica is a much more

detailed "how to" book with descriptions of techniques, etc., as well as how to read music. And it is half the price. It is, however, written for the diatonic harmonica player. In the best of all worlds, the Idiots Guide would be re-written to include info on the chromatic.
