

Katana is a very different personality than the other three supers whose books came before her, and it is really good to see this caught for girls to understand that every personality type can do courageous and kind things that make a difference in the world, and while everyone is unique and comes from their own backgrounds they can come together to do amazing things. This series is one of my favorites. It lets the girls be girls and discover their own selves for themselves. Way too often writers try to force through whatever the social agenda flavor of the month is or try and push adult or non age appropriate subject matter to try and make themselves popular and they do a huge disservice to girls when they do it. This series is all about each super discovering who their best self really is, learning how to balance independence and friendship and family, figuring out how to know what is right and good for themselves, and overcoming failures and fears and hardships in positive ways. It is a series all about becoming. It is so delightful to read books that are so encouraging of girls and instructive on such quality characteristics as hard work, compassion, intelligence, courage, and hope. This world really needs more series like this one out there. Ones

like this show true girl power.

Katana at Super Hero High by Lisa Yee is the fourth book in the DC Super Hero Girls series. The series focuses on DC's famous female super heroes, and also some villains. But before they become mortal enemies, they're just your not-so-average teenage supers that are learning what it means to be a hero and dealing with all the pressures that come along with it. The students at Super Hero high are given a legacy assignment where they must interview members of their families to find out where they came from, their histories, their roots. Katana thinks that this assignment will help uncover the mystery of her grandmother's disappearance. And if that was all she had to worry about, it would be enough, but it's not. When mysterious swords appear along with a puzzling haiku, Katana has to unravel the intrigue before danger arrives. Luckily for Katana, she has some great friends to help her out. Katana at Super Hero High is my favorite so far in this series. I loved the story line about discovering the supers' legacies, but I also loved that Yee addresses the pressures from expectations that the supers deal with. I think a lot of young kids will be able to relate. This series is all about empowering young girls and giving them heroes with all their flaws to look up to. My daughter and I both highly recommend this series!

the previous books. In the first one, readers had small glimpses of Katana and as the series expanded we got a chance to see more of her and get to know her personality. Now, we really get to know Katana and her background story. The book starts off, right where book three ended. Katana is late for Batgirl $\tilde{A}f\hat{A}\phi\tilde{A}$   $\hat{a}$   $\neg\tilde{A}$   $\hat{a},\phi$ s party and she is nowhere to be found. This is unusual of Katana and the rest of the supers start looking for her. They finally find Katana within the tunnels of Super Hero High with a hundred samural swords, which come from an unknown source along with mysterious clues that Katana has to solve in order to learn why they are related to her past. Something that I liked about the Katana portrayed in this story is that she is very artistic and well disciplined, and gives her best in everything she does, whether it  $\tilde{A}f\hat{A}\phi\tilde{A}$  â  $\neg\tilde{A}$  â,  $\phi$ s her training or school work. Another aspect I liked about Katana was her interaction with Miss Martian that later turned into a solid friendship. In this book, not only does the reader get to know more about Katana, but we also get to know more about Miss Martian who is typically in the background invisible to others. Miss Martian turns out to be a key element in solving some of Katana $\tilde{A}f\hat{A}\phi\tilde{A}$  â  $\neg\tilde{A}$  â,  $\phi$ s mysteries. Another character that gets some spotlight is Parasite, the janitor. Katana $\tilde{A}f\hat{A}\phi\tilde{A}$  â  $\neg\tilde{A}$  â,  $\phi$ s grandmother was also an interesting character, at a certain point through the book, Katana learns more about her and I just loved the way author Lisa Yee wrote this part, it had a cozy, warm feeling between grandmother and granddaughter.
