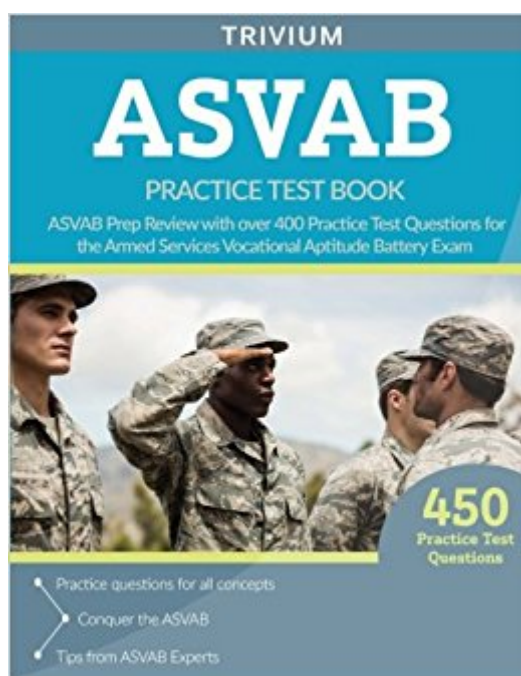

The Armed Forces Vocational Aptitude Battery (ASVAB) is one of those broad-based tests that covers a lot of ground. Just where to start can be problematic, but there are several books out there that help young people figure out just where to start. For example, there's the familiar ASVAB for Dummies, a book I'd recommend picking up right along with this one. It will give you a good idea where to start, a way to understand the test, and will help

with some strategies. As I always maintain, there's no corner on the market for any single test and different guides are a plus. If you're thinking of joining the military, the Trivium Practice Test Book will give you a pretty good idea of what you'll be up against when you take the test. The introductory material answers a lot of questions you might have. It lets you know what the ASVAB is, who is eligible to take the exam, the different versions, discusses computer adaptive testing, describes what's on the exam, describes a breakdown of subtests, scoring, qualifying scores broken down by service branch, how it's administered, and a blurb about the recruitment process. When I took the test years ago, I would have loved to have had a book like this one. This is essentially a practice test book, not a study guide, although in finding a lot of information can be garnered by working through the questions. There are many line drawings that one can refer to when answering the multiple-choice practice questions. There are two practice tests, each followed by an answer key. Unlike many tests, the ASVAB is offered in both a Computer Adaptive Testing (CAT) format and in a paper-and-pencil one. Checking out the ASVAB online is also a big help for those considering either a stint in the military or a career.

The Armed Forces Vocational Aptitude Battery test questions were varied. While I have almost no

air force knowledge, nor have I even ridden in a plane I was able to answer some of these questions as was my son (age 5). Here are a few example questions:- What is the greatest common factor of 68, 102, and 170?- The transfer of antibodies directly from one person to another results in which type of immunity?- A muscle nerve and the fibers attached to it is best described as- What subatomic particle(s) is/are located within the nucleus of an atom according to the Bohr model- The ripening of a fruit is promoted byThese are multiple choice, there is an answer key and some of the answers are explained.

This book is easy to read, full of great information, and very easy to follow. It built my confidence and helped me learn how to approach the questions to which I may not know the answer (and learned a lot of useful things in the process!). The book is divided into the sections that you'll see on the test (Word Knowledge, General Science, etc.) The practice tests are a great way to prepare. I studied this book for about two weeks before taking the practice PiCAT ASVAB for the Air Force, and got an AFQT score of 95. I feel prepared for the real test. Definitely recommend!

It's easy to over stress with any test. Especially one that can influence your promotion status and career. This book helps lay out how the ASVAB will go. It gives you so much information so you won't be blind sided when you test. The writers of the book go over a topic a few different ways with different types of questions so it helps every type of learner. You can skip the parts you know well and zone in on what you're iffy about. The printing is good and the paper quality is good as well. Over all very pleased.

This ASVAB practice test book is excellent. The guide is well organized, with each section clearly sorted into categories and subsections to optimize studying sessions and time. The tips that associated experts have contributed are logical and truly do help to minimize stress and worry, giving you a great idea of what to expect. The practice test questions are full of basic and fundamental information that is sure to pop up on the test. My students really got the most out of this guide and it is heavily used. I'd highly recommend it to others!
