

He devotes one chapter to significant developments through the centuries and another to the place of the tradition's ancient practices and ideas in the world today. Full-page sidebars feature selections from Confucian writings and teachings, which serve to both break up and add flavor to the long sections of text. A halftone map of China with some of its neighboring countries appears as a frontispiece. Illustrative material includes a map showing the extent of early Confucianism, a diagram of a typical temple, and a section of glossy color photographs of art and sculpture. A cleanly designed chronology and a simple time line help clarify the history of this tradition.
