One thing I can never criticize Julie Anne Peters of is being unable to craft remarkable characters in believable, real-life situations. It's her gift, and it gives lifeblood to "Pretend You Love Me." No one element sticks out as being particularly intense in the novel, but rather the weaving of distinct elements creates something greater than the sum of its parts. Small town, rural middle America. A family torn apart by loss and wedged apart by their own pains and regrets. The challenge of facing

love - unrequited love, seeing it blossom in others while feeling strangled by it. The meaning of friendships and being true to one's self. And how do you separate the good lessons taught to you by someone who abandoned you so completely? Written for young adults - replete with discussion questions for epilogue - the book is still a worthy read for adults. It, like several other of Ms. Peters's works (well, all of those I have read) stirs the reader to thought. And at no point is the ending clear - not until that last page is turned over. A true piece of craftsmanship.

Despite the hype surrounding this book, I disliked the ending (will not spoil it) and how manipulative a certain character could be. I love Julie Anne Peters, and while some think this is her finest work, I do not. My favorite book is *Between Mom And Jo*. I think that has what this book lacks, a ton of emotion without the...ending this one has.
