

As a lover of all strains of feline and the author of A Vague Signs of Intelligent Life & Other Wickedly Funny Fables for Adults, I was expecting a book of bizarre humor and didn't expect

anything so mild and unoffensive as this work, but as I say, I loved it! The graphics are really fun and the narrative is camp and unpredictable, especially the episode about the cat firing humans, and doing so with the compassion and sensitivity we all expect from our little carnivorous friends. "Bob" the cat is one alpha dude and should not be messed with under any circumstances, particularly if you are a human being. This book is worth every can of tuna you had to deny your companion, be it animal, vegetable or otherwise, in order to spring for this book. I like humor...quirky, weird, marginally irreverent, and like this work, oddly relevant. So, just think of your bucks as a hairball and cough it up, readers, you'll be laughing all the way to the litter box.
