

I've always had an interest in stories that join the supernatural with either world wars, so this was right up my street! A group of Nazi soldiers take over a keep in Romania during world war 2, not knowing it's already inhabited...A good read for anybody who likes gothic horror, or has seen the movie. Recommended!

An entertaining, engaging horror story that reads very quickly, this book was also my introduction to F. Paul Wilson and his Adversary Cycle. I've since started reading the first of his Repairman Jack series, and the differences in tone between The Keep and The Tomb are considerable. The Keep has virtually none of the tongue-in-cheek, tough-guy-fighting-monsters qualities of The Tomb; it's all horror, all the time. I've seen others comment positively on Wilson's ability to draw believable characters, and I feel like, while you can definitely see that quality emerging in this book, not all of

the characters are as well-developed as they could be. The Keep's only female character comes across as insipid and childish, and the romance subplot is about as shallow as anything I've seen. Other characters fare much better, though, and having read Wilson's later work I think his ability to write women has improved considerably since The Keep.All in all, I'd recommend it to horror fans. Keep your expectations relatively low and I doubt you'll be disappointed.

At first I was greatly entertained at the story then the first red herring through me. But, it was a false clue. READ ON! The ending was excellent and so satisfying.
