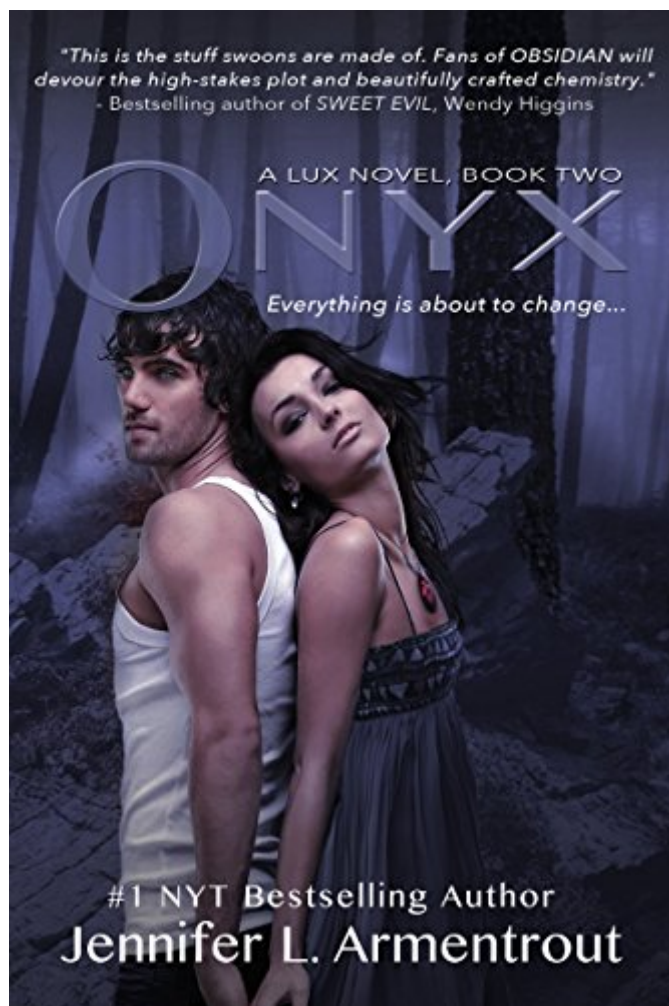

I devoured this book over the course of 24 hours. Jennifer Armentrout never fails to amaze me with her writing and her characters. Onyx starts right after the events that occurred in Obsidian. The pace of this story was perfect. It sucks you in and has you rapidly turning the pages to see what happens next. I would tell myself that I would stop after reading one more chapter and then I wouldn't be able to stop because I had to know what happened next. Before I knew it, the book was finished and now I desperately need the next one. Obsidian showed us how sexy aliens can be. Onyx comes back with just as sexy aliens, but this time with more intriguing mysteries, tons of plot twists, many revelations, mind-blowing suspense, and even hotter chemistry. We get to meet new characters in Onyx and we got to see the totally swoon-worthy, sweet side of Daemon. Katy and Daemon's conversations are full of more witty banter and absolutely frustrating yet completely satisfying sexual tension. Oh Daemon. You are making me cheat on my other book boyfriends for you. I found myself laughing out loud at Daemon's witty banter several times. This book didn't really have a love triangle. As if you can have a love triangle with Daemon around. I love that Katy is a book blogger. I loved when there were little snippets of what book she was reading at the time. After that huge cliff hanger at the end of the book, I don't know how I can possibly wait for Opal.

Firstly, I'd like to mention that this is a continuation of the Lux series and follows on from where Obsidian left off. So you need to have read that before starting this book. Once again, we follow Katy and her adventures with her alien friends. The attraction between her and Daemon is getting stronger, and now that the two of them have a connection from the ending of book one, it just gets that much more interesting. Katy keeps on denying her feelings for Daemon as he irritates her and decides to try dating a 'normal' boy being the new guy at school named Blake. Little does she know how far from 'normal' he really is and it makes for some interesting discoveries. The banter between Katy and Daemon had me chuckling once again, and Daemon's cockiness just gets better the longer the story goes. Their relationship moves up a notch and is taken to another level and is also tested in this installment. We experience a whole lot more excitement with Katy discovering more about herself and her connection to Daemon all the time and the trouble it will and does cause. Daemon is still cocky and macho but does soften with regards to Katy as his feeling for her grows. He backs off on how reckless he can be and he becomes even more swoon-worthy because of it. There is absolutely nothing I disliked about this book even with the new mystery to solve at the end of the

book, leaving it wide open and tonnes of questions needing answers at the end. But having said that, this one feels finished and I liked that aspect.
