

A very small summary of Muhammad's life, and extremely critical in understanding the Quran and Islam in general. Bill Warner is quite correct that if you want to understand Islam, you shouldn't start with the Quran, but instead, you start with the life of Mohammad, because that is the context for the Quran (And the Quran does not tell you that little secret - it assumes you know)It is critical for non-Muslims to read this book. Islam seems to be very confusing, being violent and peaceful at the same time. So, we tend to go with the opinions of the Muslims we like, hoping that their interpretation is the correct one. Understanding Muhammad's life will sort out these apparent contraditions, allowing you to understand the real Islam, and how you, as the unbelieving kafir, fit into their scheme of things.

It details his life in both Mecca and Medina and how this political (not religious) system was developed to profit the prophet (1/5th of all battle won loot went to Allah through his prophet).
